

**Great Yorkshire Run**  
**Sunday 6 September 2009**

While her club mates were running round the scenic rural course at Lockington last Sunday, Debs Brant was tackling the tough streets of industrial Sheffield in the Great Yorkshire Run.

It was a successful day for Debs who recorded another personal best for the 10k distance. She was delighted with her time of 49 minutes 04 and “even more pleased with 13<sup>th</sup> position in my age group.”

The course starts in the city centre and heads out down the fast and flat road to Hillsborough and back again. It is difficult to avoid hills in Sheffield and the stamina of all runners was tested in the last 800 metres as they headed uphill to the finish. The race attracted a field of over seven thousand and was won by Eliud Kipchoge of Kenya in 28 minutes 30. The ladies’ race was won by Britain’s Freya Murray in 32 minutes 38.
