

Race day information

Friday 8th July
Fun Run: 6:45 pm
10km: 7.30 pm

Welcome to the Specsavers Walkington 10K & Family fun Run 2022. Please read carefully the race instructions. The event returns to a mass start for this year. Race numbers and timing chips are collected on the night.

Location

The Race Headquarters is at Walkington Playing Fields, Beech View, Walkington, HU17 8SE. Please follow car park signs in the village and directions given by car park marshals in attendance.

Toilets are available but there are no showers or changing facilities.

Parking and Race Assembly

Parking is at the Playing Fields and also in the car park by the church on Kirk Lane. Note that Kirk Lane car park will not have access from 6:30pm and no exit between 6:30pm and 7pm and from 7:20pm until 9pm.

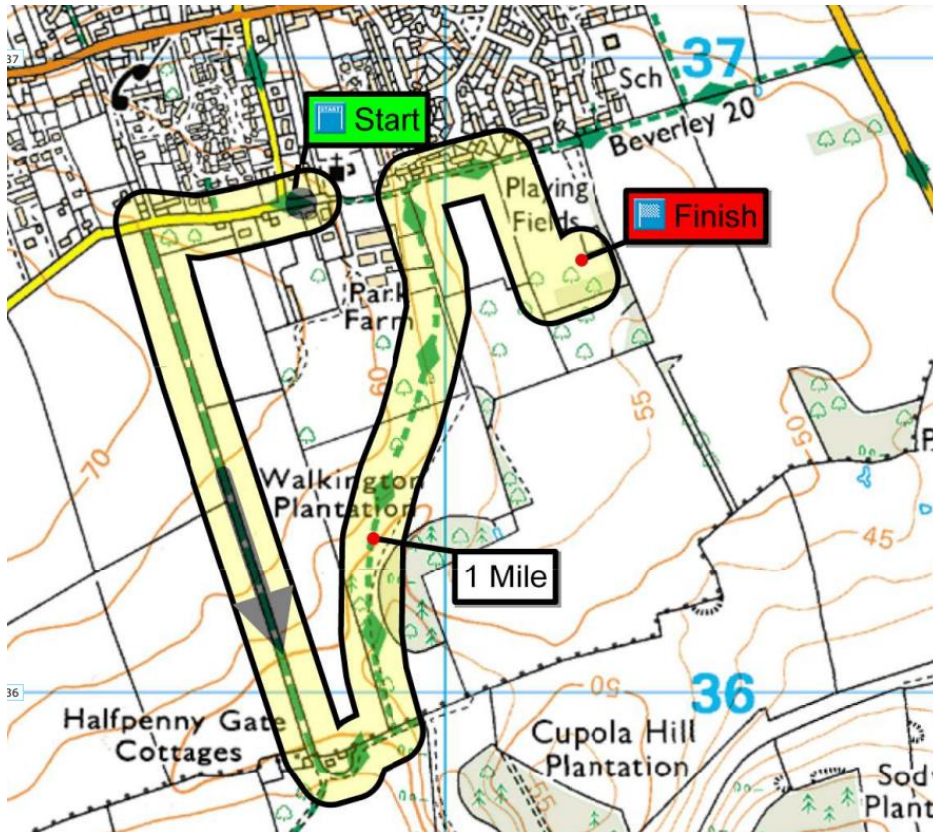
Race Number & Timing Chip

Registration will open at 6pm for both races on the left of the playing field, or in the pavilion if weather dictates. Your timing chip will be attached to your race number. Please complete the details on the reverse in case of an emergency. Do not cut or deface your number and always wear it on the front of your running top, clearly visible. Numbers are strictly non-transferable and anyone running under another person's number will be disqualified and banned from entry in future Beverley AC races. Transfers are permitted up to midnight on Wednesday 6 July via The Entry Point. Please bring safety pins.

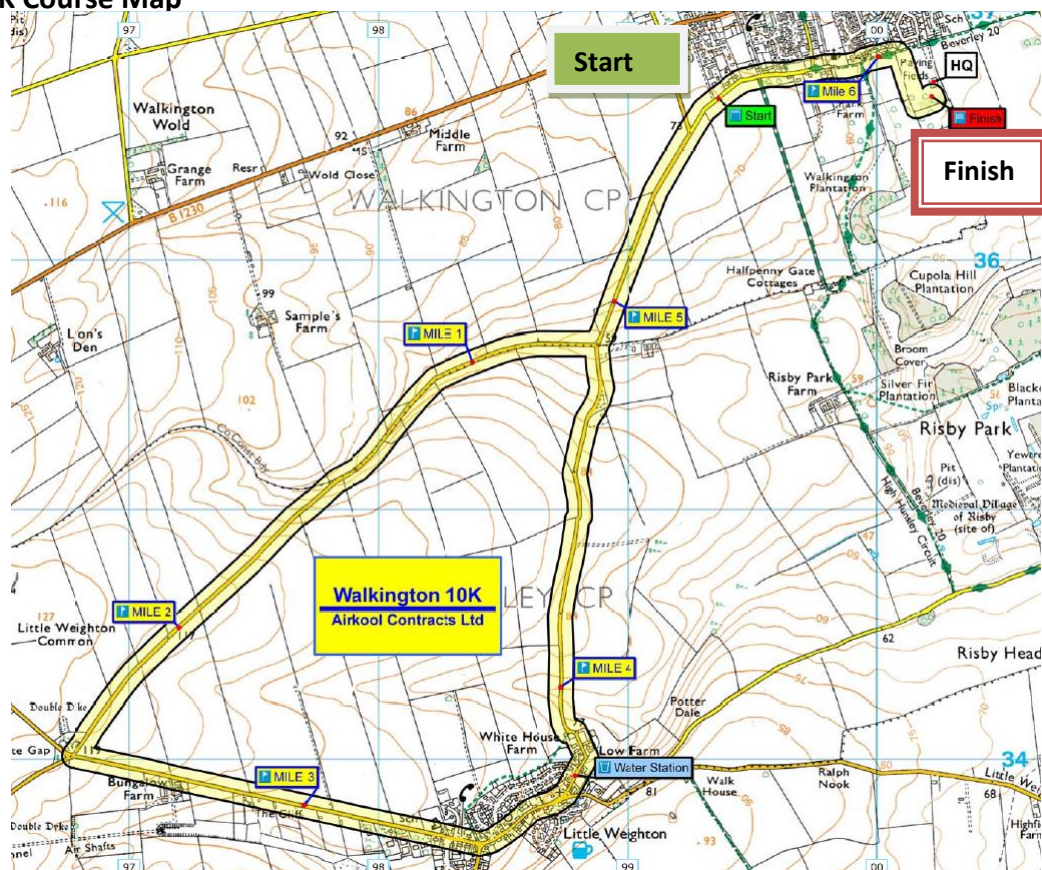
Course

The 10km course is a rural, undulating, and scenic route from Walkington returning via Little Weighton. The Fun Run course leaves the south of Walkington exploring some of the public rights of way nearby. The finish for both races is on the playing fields. Chip timing is provided by Sports Timing Solutions.

Transfer Requests

Transfers remain possible online until midnight Wednesday 6 July. Under no circumstances should a runner be given your number without undertaking this transfer process as this might cause incorrect allocation of prizes and could cause confusion if an accident or emergency were to occur. Runners found running under someone else's number will be disqualified and banned from future Beverley AC races.

Safety

Please follow the directions of marshals and have due regard for your own safety and that of other road users. Under UKA Rules of Competition you need to be aware of traffic dangers and directions given by officials.

The wearing of headphones, or similar devices is not permitted and could lead to disqualification.

Due to the unsuitability of the routes, wheelchairs, prams or pushchairs are not allowed and we do not allow runners to participate with dogs.

The Start

Both races begin on Little Weighton Road, accessed via the footpath from the playing field. Note that fun runners will be using this route to finish between 6:50 and 7:10pm approx. The race is chip timed. Please consider your estimated pace when lining up.

Spectators

Are very welcome with the playing fields a great space to cheer finishers in and residents of the villages of Walkington and Little Weighton will be out to support you. Our thanks to the communities for their support.

During the Race

Ample marshals will be along the course to ensure you don't go wrong and cheer you along. Please thank them as they are volunteering their time to make this event a safe one.

Specsavers will cycle at the head of the 10K and a back marker will follow both races. There is a cut off of 90 minutes and roads will re open based on 9 minutes a kilometre.

Drink Station

A drink station is situation around the 6km point in Little Weighton All runners will receive a bottle of 500ml water at the finish.

First Aid

North East Medical Services will be in attendance and able to respond to incidents. Please contact a marshal if you or a fellow runner requires medical attention.

Road Closures

The route will be closed to traffic throughout except for emergency vehicles. A back marker will follow the final runner. If you drop behind a pace of 90 minutes you may be asked to withdraw or find roads are open. We have to reopen them within the times agreed with the council.

The Finish

Once you have finished keep moving and you will be able to collect your race memento (medal for fun run, T-shirt for 10K) and a bottle of water. Your T-shirt size will be as per your entry system request.
